**Trans Canada Trail Walk**

**Please Note:** This walk begins at the parking lot of the Dr. Walter Chestnut Public Library on Main Street. Take Exit 172 from the Trans Canada Highway into Hartland. Turn right on Bridge Hill Road and drive through the Covered Bridge. Turn left to the parking lot before the library on your left. The library is a Start Point on the map only. There is no "Walk Box" or information at this establishment.

**TOWN OF HARTLAND**

**'Home of the Longest Covered Bridge in the World'**

1. From Dr. Walter Chestnut Public Library parking lot turn right and go a short distance to the Hartland Bridge and cross through the covered bridge to the other side. (You have just crossed the Longest Covered Bridge in the World).
2. Once on the other side of the bridge turn around and follow the walkway back to Main Street. Cross Main St at the crosswalk and turn right. Follow Main Street out to Cloverdale Road. (The river will be on your right; see how the water sparkles!). The Water Treatment Plant is on your left just before Cloverdale. (2.5 km)
3. Turn left on Cloverdale for a very short distance. Turn left onto the New Brunswick Trail (old rail bed). This is also part of the Trans Canada Trail system. Follow the trail back towards town. You will take the trail through the town crossing McMullin, Queen and Orser, keeping the river on your left hand side.
4. Turn left on Maple and then left on Main to return to the Library parking lot.(4.6 km)
