LOSIER, Diane T.



Diane Losier of Lake Fletcher died on Wednesday, January 17, 2018, in the VG Site, QEII in Halifax following a battle with late-stage cancer.

Born in Bathurst, N.B., she was the daughter of Alfred Losier and Adrienne (Blanchard) Losier. Diane was a retired French immersion teacher in Saint Catherine's School. She loved music and sang in the choir for Les Voix d'Acadie. She also studied cello under Adam Mueller, and played in a local chamber orchestra.

Diane attended continuing education courses in both Spanish and Creative Writing in Dalhousie University. She was a part of the Evergreen Writer's group, and was a published short story author in the book "Out of the Mist".

Diane had a strong spiritual faith. She was baptised Roman Catholic. She studied Buddhism in Gampbo Abbey, and through the Nalandabhodi organization. She also walked the 800km Camino de Santiago pilgrimage route in Spain.

Diane is survived by her children, Marielle and Dylan Groven; and brother, Roger Losier. A memorial will be hosted at her home on February 3rd.
