Love of God, family and country and helping others guided his life. Peter served in the Canadian Forces from 1947 to 1985 and with National Defence from 1985 to 1995. He was a proud Korean War Veteran and member of the Royal Canadian Regiment serving in London, Ontario; Rivers, Manitoba; Soest, Germany; NORAD North Bay and Ottawa. During his career, he received the Korea Medal, UN Service Medal, UN Medal (Palestine), UN Disengagement Observer Force Medal (Golan Heights), International Commission of Control and Supervision Service Medal (Vietnam), CF Decoration and Clasps and Parachute Badge.



He also volunteered at Stride repairing aids for the disabled for 20 years. Peter was also a member of the 1946-47 Bridgetown High School Hockey Team which, against all odds, won the Nova Scotia Provincial Hockey Championship. The team was inducted into the Bridgetown Sports Hall of Fame in 2012.
