Prairies and Northern Director's Walk

5 km Walk

Rating 1A

Trans Canada Trail, Community and Murals Programs

This walk begins at the Delta Bessborough Hotel 601 Spadina Crescent, Saskatoon S7K 3G8. Tel: (866) 430 4982. ***Please Note:*** The hotel is a start point on the map only. There is no "Walk Box" here.

1. At the front door of the Bessborough Hotel turn left. Take the first left path to the river which takes you through Kiwanis Park.
2. Turn right and follow the paved path along the river. The river will be on your left.
3. Do NOT go up to the steps to the Broadway bridge but walk underneath it to the sidewalk. Friendship Park is on your right.
4. Follow this sidewalk, stopping to admire the Founders statue until you come to the curving path on your left down to the river (option of stairs or bike friendly path) – you are now in a newly developed area called River Landing. At the bottom turn right on the path by the river. Keep to this path until you come to the Idylwyld Bridge. (1.3 km)
5. Walk under the bridge and continue on the path through River Landing East until the park ends.
6. Turnaround and return on the path under the Idylwyld Bridge. (2.1 km)
7. Turn left on a path up to the Prairie Fare Kiosk building. Year round washrooms are available. Take the stairs up to Spadina Crescent, turn right and walk along the sidewalk towards the Broadway Bridge.
8. Turn left on a path through Friendship Park to 19 St E, turn right.
9. Cross the bridge over the South Saskatchewan River carrying on along Broadway Avenue. Here you will find a great variety of shops, restaurants and cafes – probably now is a great time to stop and enjoy a beverage. At Main St. (3.6 km) cross left over Broadway Ave and then turn left back down Broadway (note the mural on the school on your right) crossing once more over the bridge and turn right at the end of the bridge onto the sidewalk. (4.5 km)
10. Walk past the Vimy Memorial Bandstand in Kiwanis Park. Turn left onto the last path in the park and then right back to the Bessborough.
